

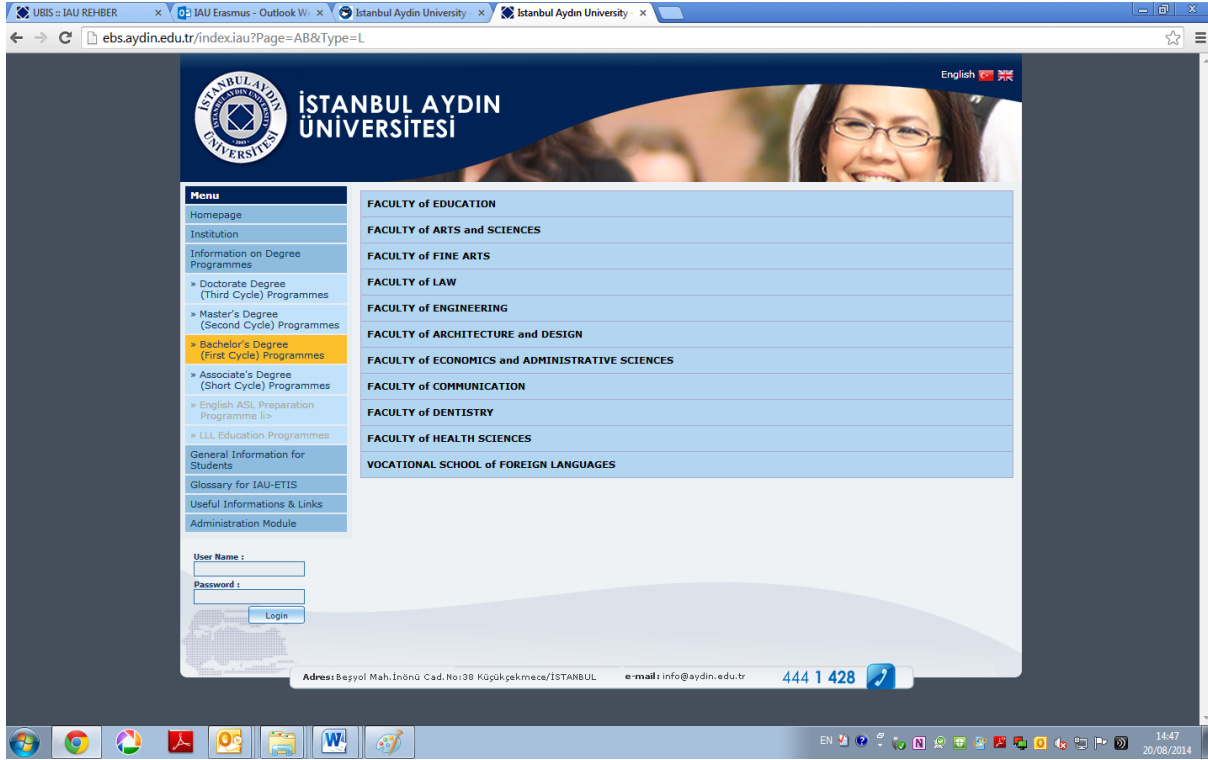


STEP 3: select your study cycle from the shown list: Associate Degree/Bachelor's degree/Master's Degree/Doctorate Degree



STEP 4: select the Vocational School/Faculty/Institute corresponding to your study area




STEP 5: click on the name of one faculty in order to display the list of departments offered in the faculty




